Northwest Chapter teaches 250 students to walk the financial walk

More than 250 high school students learned about the realities of personal and financial responsibility thanks to "Finances 101: Walk the Walk, Talk the Talk," a financial education program co-sponsored by the Northwest Chapter and Owens Community College. During International Credit Union Week, students from several Northwestern Ohio schools participated in a real-life version of the board game Life. Students were randomly assigned a job and salary, but also had to pay for life's expected and unexpected expenses such as auto insurance and car repairs. The "Walk the Walk" event taught students about how buying decisions affect earnings, the cost of running a household, and how to prevent spending beyond one's means.
